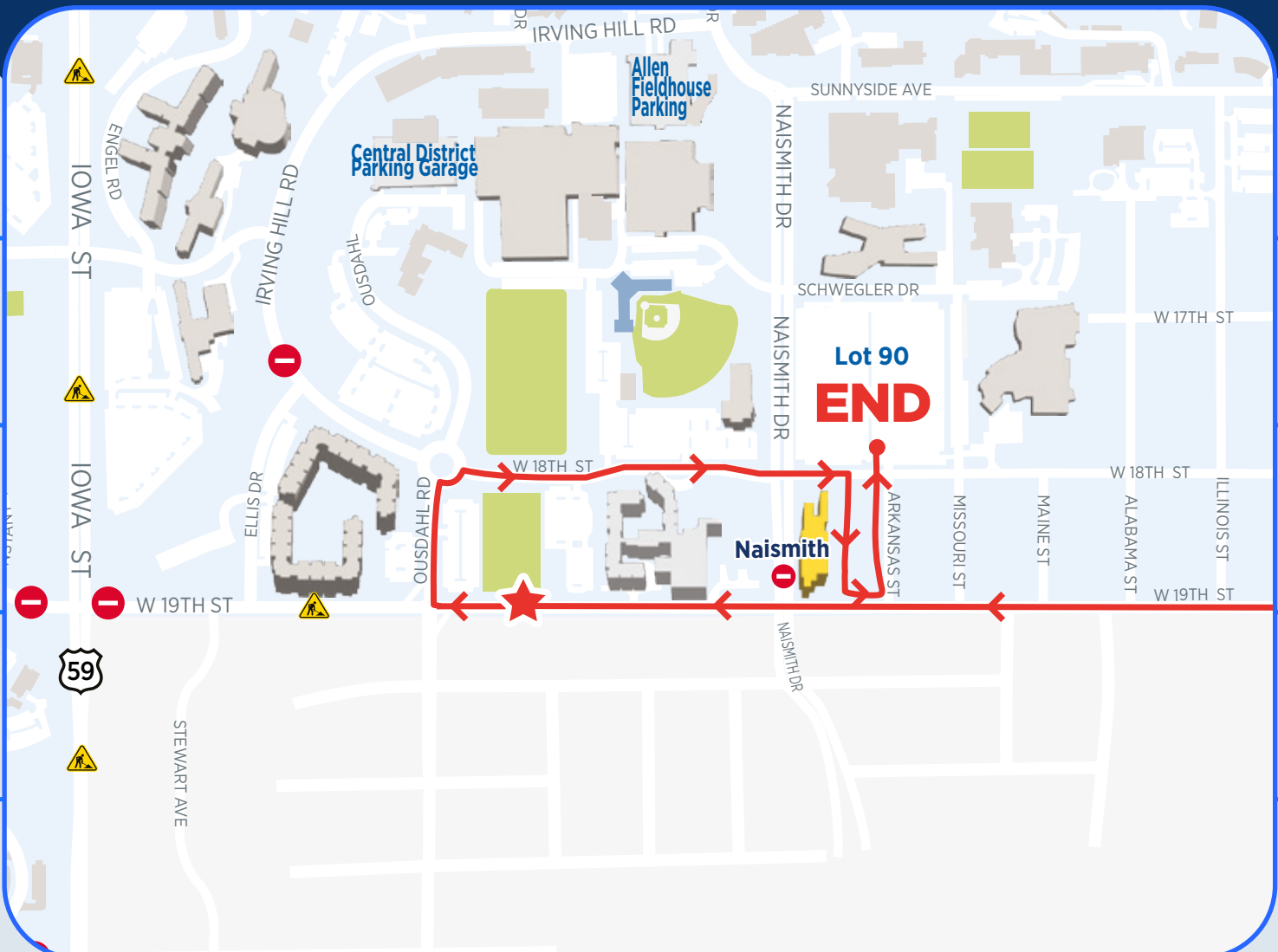
Starting Location: 1836 Ousdahl

Unloading

- If you have two vehicles, try to have the student arrive in the unloading zone first.
- Student takes KU ID card into the hall to check in and retrieve their room key. Student returns to help move items to the room.
- Guests of the student stay with the vehicle and unload at designated areas. Staff will help direct unloading.
- A driver should remain with the vehicle at all times and be available to move it.

Parking

- When finished unloading vehicles, the driver will be directed to park in Lot 90, then walk back to the residence hall.
- Persons with limited mobility should stay at the hall and not travel to long-term parking



When You Arrive

- At your arrival time, start at 19th Street and Ousdahl.
 - Note: Due to the intersection layout at 19th Street and Ousdahl, you cannot enter the intersection from the south.
- Cars will line up along 18th and then cross Naismith. Enter Naismith's parking lot from the north.
- Please print your boarding pass and display it clearly on your dashboard when you arrive for move-in.
